



## **REPELEC (AUST) COMPENDIUM 3 LUCKY DRAW PROMOTION**

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of the Conditions of Entry. Entry into the Promotion is deemed to be an acknowledgement of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The Repelec Compendium Promotion (“the Promotion”) is to be in the form of a sticker being placed into one random Compendium, issued at no charge to the customer, and distributed randomly across Australia to Repelec wholesale customers. Distribution of the winning Compendium across Australia will be dependent on volumes purchased by wholesalers in each State.
3. The promotion will run from 1 December 2008 until all 15,000 Compendiums have been distributed, or until 30 September 2009 (whichever falls first).
4. Fifteen thousand (15,000) Repelec Compendiums will be printed of which ten (10) will be deemed “winning Compendiums” (10 in 15,000 chance of prize). Winning Compendiums will have an individual sticker placed at random on a page within the Compendium. A winning Compendium will be determined by finding a valid sticker.
5. The total prize pool for the promotion is \$598 with the individual prize value being \$299. Registration for claims for prizes from the winning Compendium must be done prior to 30 September 2009.
6. All winning prizes are to be considered as having been awarded to the company concerned, being either a wholesale distributor or customer of a wholesale distributor, and not to any individual employed by the company or purchasing goods on behalf of that company. Prizes can only be awarded to individuals where the company, proprietors or authority holder of the company have provided written authorization.



7. After conclusion of the Promotion:
  - a) all unregistered winning Compendiums will be deemed invalid,
  - b) all registered and verified prize claims will be met notwithstanding the advertised prize pool has been exceeded,
  - c) all registered winning and non winning Compendiums will be entered into the second chance draw for all unclaimed prizes in the prize pool.
8. Prize claimers need to register to claim prize via fax to Repelec on 1300 666 066 giving details of name, address and contact details on a provided registration form. They also need to include a photocopy of the prize-winning sticker.
9. Prizes will be forwarded to the wholesaler who supplied the winning Compendium within 28 days of registration and verification of winning Compendium sticker. Winner will be contacted when prize is available for collection. Winning Compendium must be presented when collecting/receiving prize.
10. A “second chance draw” will be held on 1 November 2009 in the advent of an unclaimed prize. All non-winning Compendium holders will be given the opportunity to register for the second chance draw via the Repelec website. All registrations for entry into the second chance draw must be done by 30 September 2009. Compendium sticker will be randomly placed at the office of the Promoter. Prizes will be forwarded to the place of purchase within 28 days of second chance draw. Winner will be contacted when prize is available for collection. Compendium must be presented when collecting/receiving prize. After three (3) months from the second chance draw any unclaimed prize will be forfeited.
11. The winner of the prize over the value of \$100 will be listed for public viewing on the Repelec web page on 7 November 2009. All SA winners of prizes over the value of \$100, and all VIC winners of prizes over the value of \$250 will be listed in the Australian Newspaper on 7 November 2009 under ‘Public Notices’.
12. The value of the prize listed is accurate at the time of listing on the Repelec (Aust) web page. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the prize after that date. The prize value cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash.



13. The Promoter acknowledges that printing errors or other quality control matters outside the control of the individual prize claimer shall not be used as the sole basis for refusing to award a prize.
14. The Promoter will not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever (including injury or damage to property) which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained as a result of receiving, taking or using any prizes, except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law.
15. All personal details of the prize claimers will be held at the office of the Promoter. Prize claimers may request to the Promoter, in writing, any updates or corrections to be made to personal information. The Promoter advises that personal information will not be used for marketing purposes.
16. Any liability for Commonwealth, State or other taxes imposed on any prize resulting from the promotion, shall be the sole responsibility of the prize recipient and not the Promoter.
17. Prizes are unable to be claimed by employees and their immediate families of the promoter and by employees of Repelec (Aust).
