

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE



After removing sufficient roof screws, unpack your MR PEELER.

Note: the bag can be used to store the roof screws.




Insert the stainless steel bolt through the best positioned screw hole and attach the 'Lifting Ring'. Note: 'best position' is dependant on the situation.



Once the lifting ring is secure, attach the 'Snap Lock hook'.



Using the chain, pull back firmly to 'peel' back the roofing sheet, being cautious not to overbend and cause a kink in the sheet.



Select an appropriate roofing screw and back off partially, to allow the 'Fixing Plate' to slide over the head of the roofing screw.



Once the fixing plate is in place, adjustment may be necessary to shorten the chain to suit the application. You now have safe access to the ceiling space.
